POINTS/AWARDS RULES

Points/Awards Sign Up

A) Horses must be signed up with the 2009 Points/Awards Sign Up sheet prior to the date of the first show you wish points to be counted. *Example:* Raven is entered in a show on April 15th, 2009 and places in a lot of classes. Raven must be signed up in each division prior to April 15th for her points to be counted for 2009 year end division awards.

B) Amateur or Junior riders must be signed up as "Rider/Handler" with the 2009 Points/Awards Sign Up sheet prior to the date of the first show they wish the points to be counted. Amateur and Junior rider/handler points are considered "team" points in that it is a one rider/one horse system. *Example:* Arlene enters her horses Raven and Nick in AAOTR HA Western class and Arabian AAOTR Western class (respectively) at a show on May 1, 2009. Arlene signed up with Raven but not Nick prior to the show. Thus only Arlene and Raven's points will count towards Arlene's rider award. Because Arlene did not sign up Nick, any points they win together will not count towards Arlene's Amateur awards. If Arlene signs up both Raven and Nick then any points accumulated will be applied to the respective "team".

C) There are no "cross over" points. *Example:* Arlene has signed up Raven for Green Horse, Halter, Performance, Other (Open) and Dressage and herself in the Amateur, Novice Exhibitor and Open Exhibitor divisions.

Raven and Arlene go to a schooling show and compete in classes in all of the divisions they are signed up for and place in all (lucky team!). The Open Horse points will not count as Green Horse and the Green Horse points will not Count towards Open nor will the Open Exhibitor count towards Novice Exhibitor. Each is it's own division...no cross over points.

Submission of Points

AHA Events:

Because points for AHA Events are calculated using both the number of horses in the class and your placing in the class a copy of the Show Statement Sheet from the Show Secretary must be submitted to the Points Chairman before points will be tallied. The Statement Sheet will indicate each class you participated in, the number of horses in the class and the placing of the class..

You may obtain the Statement Sheet from the Show Secretary at the conclusion of your classes at the Show or you may request a statement from AHA.

There is a 30 day time frame for submitting the points to the Point Chairman. It is greatly appreciated if you submit the statement sheet as soon as possible after the show for processing by the Points Committee. This will allow the Points Committee to submit a running tally of points to be printed monthly in the Chatter.

You may mail, hand deliver or email the Statement Sheet to the Points Chairman. You will receive a notification by mail (postcard) or email that the Statement was received. If you do not get a notification within a reasonable time please contact the Chairman to verify your points were calculated. This will eliminate any confusion on whether or not your points were received.
