### General Rules and Information (as applicable to your breed):

Cancellation or Substitution of Entries: To encourage early entries, the management agrees to cancel and refund all fees for any horse not fit to show provided written notice is given to the Show Secretary on or before entry closing date. Horses may be scratched from the show at the owner's option. Refunds will be considered for any horse suffering from illness or injury upon the presentation of a veterinarian's certificate to the Show Secretary PRIOR to 9pm September 9, 2010. ALL REQUESTS FOR A REFUND MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A VETERINARIAN'S CERTIFICATE AND MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE SHOW SECRETARY. A \$20 office fee will be retained by RVAHA for entries cancelled with a vet certificate.

Refusal of Entries: The management reserves the right to hold classes conditionally, or cancel entries of any contest.

Entry Form Checklist: Entries must be submitted on the official entry form for this show. Entries not accepted via fax. Please print clearly and legibly to complete the entry form or use Adobe Acrobat to fill in the form on your computer. If additional forms are required, please make photocopies or print additional copies from the RVAHA website [www.rvaha.org](http://www.rvaha.org).

After completing the entry form, mail it together with the following to the address listed below.

- a check (not postdated) for all charges
- a copy of both sides of the registration papers for ALL horses entered
- a copy of the AHA COMPETITION LEVEL MEMBERSHIP CARD for the owner, trainer and all riders and handlers for Arabian/HA/AA horses.
- a copy of the purchase contract if the owner listed on the entry form is not the owner shown on the registration papers.

Paddock and Conduct: There shall be no conduct in the paddock area which disturbs or creates a hazard to horses or handlers, or spectators, except the whip properly carried by a handler in the paddock area.

Registration Requirements: Horses showing in the Arabian classes at this show must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Association, Inc. and/or the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry in order for the AHA Community Show points to count. For open class points to count a copy of your registration papers and appropriate reporting paperwork must be submitted. NO BLANK FORMS will be signed by the show Secretary for reporting points.

Indemnity and Non-Responsibility: All entries are accepted with the understanding that RVAHA will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any horse exhibited or any article of any kind. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Committee, but solely the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by any animal owned or exhibited by him, and shall indemnify RVAHA and Arabian Horse Association and Oregon Horsemen's Association and their representatives against any and all loss, damages and liability thus occasioned, included, but not limited to, any and all legal costs, including attorney fees which may incur as a result thereof. The submission of any Entry Form to the Show Secretary shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing same of the provisions herein set forth.

A Junior Equine is a horse age 5 and under. A Senior Equine is age 6 and over. Rider's age is as of January 1, 2010. Discipline: Exhibitors are warned that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials of this show on the part of the owner, exhibitor, agent, trainer, lessee, groom, rider, driver, or handler will be considered cause for removal from the show without being liable for compensation or damages.

Judges: If for any reason a judge fails to attend this show or to perform his/her duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute a judge for one who is officially designated in the Prize List.

Management: Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or reorder classes, add or substitute judges, or make other changes as required for the betterment of the show. Classes with no entries by the closing day of entries may be cancelled.

Showing from Trailers: Exhibitors MAY show from their trailers. If showing, from a trailer, it must be parked in the parking lot area.

**Class Calls: All exhibitors are responsible for making their classes. Due to unforeseen problems with any mechanical device, the public address system and paddock calls over that system must be considered a courtesy. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure that his/her horse is at the gate at the prescribed time. Every effort will be made to maintain a working public address system to carry class calls. However, no protest will be upheld, nor will any section be changed on the basis of public address malfunction alone. The two minute gate rule will be observed.**

Stabling: It is recommended that exhibitors wishing to be stabled together submit their entries together. Regular stalls with doors are available. The Jackson County Expo Center DOES NOT ALLOW THE USE OF STRAW BALES FOR BEDDING. Debris is to be deposited in designated areas ONLY. Each horse must be assigned a separate stall (exception: broodmares with suckling foals). Horses must be placed in stalls assigned. Stalls will be available Friday after 12 o'clock noon. Early arrivals MUST make arrangements with show management PRIOR to arrival.

Stallions: Stallions may not be shown by persons under 18 years of age.

Persons 17 years and under must wear an ASTM/SEI approved helmet.

Maiden equine is not have won a first place ribbon in that particular division.

Novice equine is not to have won 3 blues in that particular division.

Limit is not to have won 6 blues in that particular division.

Green Equine, regardless of age, is described as being in its first year of showing under saddle or harness in that division (western, English and/or driving). Competing under saddle or harness in the specific division at any shows, including schooling shows, prior to January 1 of the current year excludes the equine from an OHA green class. Prior year halter and/or in-hand exhibition does not affect eligibility for green status.

No vehicles to be driven by persons without a valid drivers license, including golf carts, scooters, etc.

Dogs: Dogs NOT TO BE ALLOWED IN GRANDSTAND AREAS OR SHOW OFFICE. Dogs in any other area of the facility must be on a leash or confined.

**NO TELEPHONE ENTRIES. NO ENTRIES ACCEPTED WITHOUT PAYMENT. A \$25 FEE WILL BE CHARGED FOR ALL RETURNED CHECKS.**

**Refunds: With Vet Certificate, if presented no later than 9:00pm Sept. 9, 2010.**

**A \$20 office fee will be retained.**

POST ENTRIES, SCRATCHES OR CHANGES SHOULD BE MADE AT LEAST FIVE CLASSES PRIOR TO THE CLASS ENTERED.

**AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL ARABIAN/HA/AA ONLY CLASSES: ALL riders, drivers, handlers and trainers MUST HAVE A CURRENT AHA COMPETITION LEVEL MEMBERSHIP CARD and provide the show with the following:**

- 1. Legible copy of the current AHA Competition Level Membership Card or pay the Single Event Membership Fee.**
- 2. Submit a current copy of the horse's registration papers.**

Copy of current member card showing member number with AHA is required for all riders wishing to participate in the AHA ACS Awards Programs. Copy of registration papers will be required for any horse showing in Arabian or Half Arabian classes. You do not have to be the recorded owner, but the horse has to be registered with AHA. This information is needed for recording of points with AHA. Membership in AHA is required for inclusion in ACS Awards Program. Non-AHA members can show in the ACS but those exhibitors will not qualify for or accumulate points towards the ACS Awards Program. Professionals may show in Arabian/HA/AA classes but cannot be pinned. AHA points will not count for Professionals or the horses they ride. Professionals may ride and place in non AHA classes.

I have read and understand the ACS Guidelines and agree to be bound by and subject to those Guidelines. I have also read and understand the rules concerning this Arabian Community Show, and agree to be bound by and subject to those rules.

**AHA ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION**

This document waives very important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

In consideration for AHA permitting me to participate in this Arabian Community Show, and by signing the entry blank, I agree as follows:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Arabian Community Show, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. **I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS ARABIAN COMMUNITY SHOW INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN, AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.**

Should a hearing be requested, I agree to accept AS FINAL the decision of the particular hearing body. I agree to release, hold harmless and not to sue AHA, the Arabian Community Show Sponsoring Organization, their officers, directors, employees, volunteers or members concerning any decision of the Arabian Community Show, its Show Commission, Show Officials or any hearing body that relates to my qualifications or my horse(s) qualifications to enter the Arabian Community Show or any results of the Arabian Community Show.

I AGREE that AHA and the ACS Sponsoring Organization have the sole right to control, sell, supervise or give away (or assign to others the right to do so) the exclusive rights to broadcast, televise, reproduce, transmit and disseminate all or part of this event, and I agree that AHA may use or assign, in any way AHA sees fit, photographs, films, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the Arabian Community Show for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the Arabian Community Show or AHA. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way which implies endorsement of any company, product, product category or service. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.

By signing below as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and agree to all of the above provisions, and further agree to assume all of the obligations of this AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification personally and on behalf of the child.

This AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification is governed by the Laws of the State of Colorado and is intended to be interpreted as broadly as possible. I agree that exclusive jurisdiction and venue (place) for any legal action against AHA, its officers, directors, employees, volunteers or agents shall be in the local district courts or the federal court of the State of Colorado. If any part of this agreement is determined to be unenforceable, all other parts shall remain in effect.

**ACS Sponsoring Organization Release, Assumption of Risk, Waiver and Indemnification**
